

Chase the Queen House Rules

1. Chase the Queen tickets will be sold at The Press Room, and may be sold at other special events. Tickets will be sold at a cost of \$1 each. There is no limit to the number of tickets one can purchase. The draw for the winning ticket and a chance to draw the Queen of Hearts will happen weekly on Thursday nights at 5:30pm. A designated draw supervisor will conduct the draw procedure.
2. Ticket sales are restricted to those 21 years of age or older. The designated draw supervisor and anyone assisting with that week's draw is not permitted to purchase that week's tickets. All other volunteers including ticket sellers are permitted to purchase tickets. Ticket sellers reserve the right to refuse the sale of tickets.
3. Each participant is responsible for checking their purchased tickets at the time of purchase to assure tickets have been properly separated and the purchaser is required to write name and phone # on ticket and place in ticket receptacle prior to the draw.
4. 50% of the weekly proceeds will benefit Prescott Park Arts Festival, a 501c3 organization in the arts community, 20% of weekly proceeds awarded to drawn ticket holds, and 30% of weekly proceeds will accumulate as the Queen of Hearts jackpot until the Queen of Hearts is drawn. The draw procedure will be visible to participants to see.
5. In addition to the minimum 30% starting jackpot, there will be an additional \$1,000 added to the starting jackpot until the accumulated jackpot total exceeds \$1,000.
6. One winning ticket will be drawn for both the weekly proceeds cash prize, and a chance to draw the Queen of Hearts from a deck of cards and potentially win the jackpot.
7. Cards are to be shuffled, and then cut by the winner, and the top card will then be turned over and revealed by a member of the organization (Prescott Park Arts Festival). Once there are 20 or less cards remaining, the cards will be spread out on a surface (face down) and mixed sufficiently. The ticker winner or a representative will then put one finger on the selected card. The draw supervisor will remove all surrounding cards while the ticker winner or representative holds their finger on the selected card. Once the surrounding cards have been removed, the selected card will be turned over by the draw supervisor.
8. If the Queen of Hearts is turned up, the winning ticket (as evidenced by name on the ticket) receives the accumulated amount in the Chase the Queen jackpot, which also includes current weeks proceeds. The winner must provide name, address and social security # and complete a W9. The winner will receive a dated and signed jackpot receipt showing the total amount of the jackpot. The jackpot will be paid by check from the Prescott Park Arts Festival within 3 business days from the date of draw and only after all information is obtained and will be subject to all IRS rules.
9. If the card drawn is not the Queen of Hearts, the card is removed from the desk and cut in half, one half is discarded and the other half is posted for display each week. The amount in the Chase the Queen jackpot then carries forward to the next draw, adding

another 30% of the ticket proceeds the next week and so on. The remaining deck will be secured in a locked box.

10. If one of two jokers is drawn, the ticket holder wins \$100 from the jackpot, and the joker is returned to the remaining deck.
11. The winning ticket holder does not need to be present to win, but must claim their prize within 48 hours of being called by Prescott Park Arts Festival. Any prize unclaimed will be forfeited to Prescott Park Arts Festival.
12. Once the Queen of Hearts is revealed, the game is concluded. This may happen on the first draw or any draw thereafter.
13. In the event of storms/cancellations, the event will continue as usual on the following Thursday. The organizer reserves the right to change the date of the draw when other community events are in conflict.
14. The contest will continue every Thursday until the Queen of Hearts is drawn. In the event the game gets to the point where the venue cannot accommodate an increased number of participants safely, advance notice will be posted to relocate to a new location, or a special draw day announced to give the jackpot away to a ticket holder to end the game. On that special day, if the first person whose number is called does not draw the Queen of Hearts, this will continue until the Queen of Hearts is drawn and the jackpot is won.
15. For promotional purposes, any Chase the Queen prize winner will automatically be deemed to grant Prescott Park Arts Festival a right to publish, through all types of media broadcasting, including internet, their full name, hometown, and photograph without any claim for broadcast, print or other rights. Any winner who is paid a prize also gives the organizer their right to publish any additional information that they voluntarily provide.
